Race and Cruise for Charity From the Past Commodore

Nice weather, eh? Anne and I drove *Andiamo!* to Douglas Harbour on Sunday in the driving rain. A few of us are there, and we weren't alone when we arrived. Roger and Jackie were on board doing maintenance – relationship or boat I'm not sure. Rod Pickles and Alan Mason showed up in their slickers to check things out as well. The first race of the season is the Grand Lake Premier and takes place this Saturday June 17th in the Lake. On the next Saturday, we will run the Charity Race on the Lake for the first time. The idea was to provide a good venue and also to give everyone more time to raise money.

The beneficiaries of our fundraising for the past two years have been youth who otherwise would have no opportunity to learn to sail, through the Fredericton Youth Sailing School. Last year we funded four youth, mostly through the awesome fundraising of Frank Camm. Our partners in this venture are Partners for Youth.



This year we want to do the same or better. *It's not about racing*, after all, it's about the kids who learn a great team sport as a result of our efforts. This year, as the title suggests, we want to not only raise money through the race program, but to involve all club members in the efforts. Because many of our fleet will not be in Douglas Harbour on the race day, we are proposing other ways to get involved:

1. Douglas Harbour will be the scene of the annual Charity Race, and the racers have challenged everyone to raise a minimum of \$75 per boat as an entry fee. Noting that it isn't always the racers who are the best fundraisers (note Frank Camm's efforts last year as top (by FAR) fundraiser) we are suggesting two other events;
2. Cruisers who have made it to the Lake or to other locations can potentially raise money by taking friends and the like for a cruise on the day, and ask their friends to contribute;
3. All those who stay in Fredericton for the summer, or who haven't left for foreign shores could do the same – take some friends or business acquaintances for a sail and ask for donations to this worthy cause.

Of course, there is not only the gratification of supporting our sport through this worthy cause; there is at least one other incentive:

Andy and Gisele Belyea of Joy of Framing have generously donated a framed print to go to the top "non-racer" fundraiser. As well, the overall top fundraiser gets the usual trophy and recognition at the annual meeting as well as in the Log.
